Annually subscribing in writing to renew membership as noted in *Bylaw 2.2(a)*Membership in the Society shall be available only to individuals interested in furthering the Society's purposes and who wholeheartedly accept, adopt and subscribe annually in writing to the Society's Statements of Vision and Mission and Values and Statement of Faith and been accepted into membership in the Society by resolution of the Board or in such other manner as may be determined by the Board.



Statement of Faith

We believe—

- 1. In one God in three persons Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Deut. 6:4, Gen. 1:26)
 - a) God the Father is the source of all that is good. He initiates creation and redemption which He accomplishes through His Son and the Holy Spirit. (Rev. 4:11, Isa. 53:4–5; Matt. 8:16–17)
 - b) The deity of the Lord Jesus Christ, His atonement for sin through the cross, His bodily resurrection and His personal, visible return to earth to reign in righteousness and glory. (John 3:16 or 2 Cor. 5:21; Luke 24: 6-7; Matt. 25:31-34)
 - c) The Person of the Holy Spirit and His work of conviction, regeneration, and sanctification, who indwells every believer equipping them with gifts for service and witness. (1 Thessalonians 5:23, Acts 1:8, Romans 6:1–14)
- 2. In the Bible as originally given by God, divinely inspired, infallible, entirely trustworthy and the supreme authority in all matters of life and faith. (2 Pet. 1:20–21; 2 Tim. 3:15–17)
- 3. In the necessity of new birth, in salvation by faith in Jesus Christ alone and the importance of a life fully committed to the will of God in Christ. (1 John 2:2, Rom. 3:21–24, Titus 3:4–7, Rom. 8:14–16; John 1:12; Acts 4:12)
- 4. In the church as the one universal body of Christ who is the Head, called to be God's redeemed people. (1Corinthians 12:12-13)
- 5. That each life is a gift from God and therefore is valuable. Because of this, we believe it is important to treat all individuals with respect and kindness, regardless of their personal beliefs. We acknowledge the command of Christ to love our neighbours, resulting in service to the Church and society, in seeking reconciliation for all with God and their fellowman, in proclaiming liberty from every kind of oppression; and in spreading Christ's justice in an unjust world until He comes again. (Mark 12:28-31)
- 6. That creation is a gift from God which we are to steward in a way that points everyone back to the goodness and love of God. (John 1:3-4, Genesis 1:1-2, 26)
